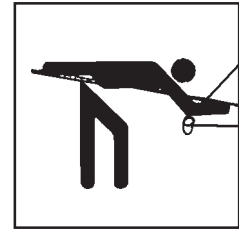


Billiards, Snooker & Pool



Dimensions for sport playing areas

1. ENGLISH BILLIARDS is played on a special table by two players or pairs. Three balls are used - white, spot white and red. Players use a cue to propel their cue ball across the table to score points by pocketing balls (hazards) or by hitting both other balls (cannons).

2. SNOOKER is played on a pocket billiard table using fifteen red, six coloured and one white cue ball. Points are scored by pocketing balls and forcing an opponent to give away points through "snookers". It may be played by two persons, pairs or teams.

Table Dimensions

The English standard billiard table is 3.658m long x 1.867m wide and between 0.851m to 0.877m above floor level. With a 50mm wide cushion overhang, actual playing surface is 3.582m x 1.796m. A three-quarter size table is 2.744m x 1.4m wide. A half size table is 1.829m x 0.934m.

Space about Table

Recommended minimum space about table is 2.5m (absolute minimum is 1.6m).

For an English standard table: 8.658m x 6.867m. For three-quarter size table: 7.744m x 6.4m. For half size table: 6.829m x 5.934m.

Lighting

Tables must be well lit and special lighting equipment is normally used.

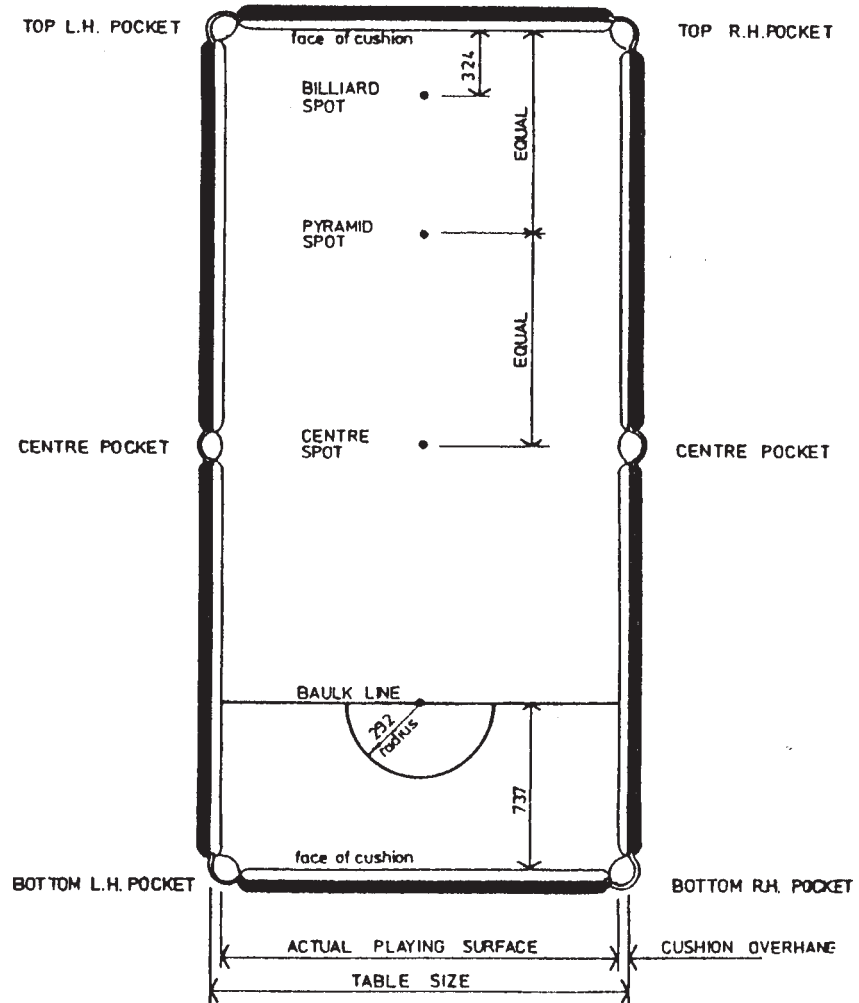


DIAGRAM OF BILLIARD TABLE

3. POOL is played on a pocket billiard table with one white cue ball and fifteen numbered object balls. It can be played by two individuals, pairs or teams. Points are scored for pocketing designated balls in designated pockets. The first player or side to reach an agreed number of points wins the game.

The Table

A slate base, covered with green baize. There are six pockets. The length is always twice the width. Size approximately 1.5m x 3.05m x 0.788m high. Recommended space around table is 2.5m, and the absolute minimum is 1.6m.
